


'BRIO/HYPERION' LEGACY VERSION UPGRADE TO 'ORACLE HYPERION INTERACTIVE REPORTING STUDIO' (Version 11): IMPORTANT CHANGES

You may notice a few changes when viewing the new Oracle Hyperion Interactive Reporting Studio (Version 11) software compared to the legacy versions of Brio/Hyperion. The changes are minor but we want everyone to be aware.

Below are a few enhancements to look for within the new application:

Within a report, the report content is identical; however, the **section icons** are different:



- Limits are now called **Filters** :



- The outline is now called **Data Layout** :



- In the table and pivot sections, some icons have changed:

• Old version :




• New version :

- Sort ascending

- ▣ Inserting a new pivot:
 - ▣ Side Labels are now called → Row Labels
 - ▣ Top Labels are now called → Column Labels



Other Information:

When using Version 11 and initially opening a legacy version '.BQY' file you will receive a 'convert' prompt (shown below). Check 'Use this choice for all subsequent documents opened and do not show this dialog' and click 'OK'. This will allow Version 11 to properly run legacy BQY files. To date, converting your BQY has not caused issues when using legacy versions of Brio/Hyperion.



When using Version 11 and initially opening a legacy version 'OCE' you will receive a 'convert' prompt (shown below). Check 'Do not show this dialog again.' and click 'OK'. This will allow Version 11 to properly run legacy OCE. To date, converting your OCE has not caused issues when using legacy versions of Brio/Hyperion.
